### **Pool and Tennis Court Rules**

The swimming pool and tennis court are for the exclusive use of members of Barrington Park Recreational Association. The rules and regulations, which are listed below, are for the protection and benefit for all to assure safe and sanitary operation of the pool and tennis court. Resident's cooperation in abiding by these rules will assure a pleasant, relaxing and recreational experience for all concerned. Failure to comply with the rules shall be considered sufficient cause for any action deemed necessary by the Association including barring of violators from the use of the pool and tennis court areas.

- **POOL AND TENNIS COURT HOURS** – Pool hours are posted at the pool. Tennis court hours are daylight hours only! Anyone found trespassing inside the fenced pool and tennis court area after posted hours may be prosecuted to the full extent of the law.
- There are no lifeguards at the pool. You are responsible for the safety and well-being of your family and guests.
- Parents will be responsible for damage caused by their minor children in and around the pool, clubhouse and tennis court area.
- The telephone is located in the pool area. This is for emergencies only.
- There is a limit of four (4) guests per household. Rental of the clubhouse does not include use of the pool.
- Be sure the pool area gates are closed and locked upon entering and exiting the pool area. Do not prop gates open.
- Making forts or dragging pool furniture in and around the pool area on its painted surfaces or sides damages the furniture and is not allowed.

### **SAFETY AND HEALTH**

- No children should be in the pool without parent/guardian supervision.
- No glass containers of any kind are permitted in the pool area.
- No running, pushing, wrestling, rowdy behavior or causing a disturbance in or around the pool, tennis court or clubhouse area.
- No diving/flipping or rowdy horse play of any kind.
- No bikes, skateboards, scooters, hee-lies, roller blades, or vehicles of any kind will be allowed inside the gated area of the pool or tennis court area.
- Swim diapers are required for swimmer in diapers. If an accident occurs, you are responsible for contacting the Association Management Company, NHE and for all costs incurred for clean-up and treatment of the pool. NHE phone number is: 864-467-1600.
- No food allowed within 6 feet of the pool. No eating or drinking allowed in the pool.
- No smoking in the pool area.
- No persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs may use pool.
- Persons with communicable disease or skin/eye/ear/nasal infections may not use pool.
- No pets or animals in pool or tennis court area.
- Pool toys and flotation devices should not be used if the pool is crowded.

- No water balloons are to be used at the pool. Water balloons can and have gotten into our pool pump system causing considerable damage.
- Always dispose of personal trash and remove personal belongings before leaving pool area. Make sure to check restrooms for any personal items.
- Make sure all umbrellas are lowered when leaving pool area.
- No loud music allowed in pool area.
- Damage to pool property will be billed to the responsible homeowner.
